### 11. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- 1. The possibility of training depends on weather and can spread over many weeks or months if you can only train on weekends and/or your schedule is not flexible.
- 2. The amount of flights one will achieve is also estimated. There is a slight possibility that you will only manage several flights if your skills are below average and will need to pay more to complete the 30 flights requirement.
- 3. Learning how to fly foot launched PPG is quite demanding and requires good level of coordination and fitness. To complete 30 flight and total 5 hrs of flight time is a serious undertaking.
- 4. Charges are per hour per person min charge per trip to the field is 2 hrs
- 5. PPG course fee is non transferable and non refundable any credit left on the account can be applied to flying for pleasure or to purchase PPG equipment sold by Rier Limited
- 6. All prices are cash discounted. If you wish to use VISA or MC I will add 3.5 % to your total bill
- 7. Any unused training hours or credits on your account will expire after 1 year of inactivity
- 8. Training sessions cancelled less then 24 hrs in advance will be charged 1 hr
- 9. All sales of equipment are final no returns
- 10. It is the participant's responsibility to arrange and have third party liability insurance through Marsh Silver Wings plan
- 11. We will not fly in wind over 20 km/h
- 12. After 6 months of inactivity student who did not solo, must pass the Pstar exam again
- 13. The training fields I use are for training only you will have to secure your own place/s to fly from
- 14. Shop rate for repairs is \$ 75 per hour 1 hr minimum charge
- 15. If any anything unexpected happens such as sickness of the instructor, equipment break down, temporary loss of field access, training will be put on hold until the issue is resolved.
- 16. Course pricing is held for 1 year. Purchase of training time after 1 year will reflect current course price
